Dear Parents and Carers

I'm really pleased to let you know that Woodhouse is ranked as the top middle school in Staffordshire based on the 2016 KS2 Sat results (the percentage of children achieving the new expected standard in reading, writing and maths).

We have also again been awarded the highest categorisation by Staffordshire County Council's school improvement and quality assurance team. This judgement is based on the following criteria:

- Published achievement information over time is at least in line with national averages;
- The educational performance data of pupils with particular characteristics is at least in line with national averages;
- Proven leadership capacity, including of governors, demonstrated by sustained high standards or a trajectory of rapid improvement;
- Other data about the school such as changes in pupil cohort size, attendance and mobility of pupils provide no concern;
- Effective safeguarding procedures in place.

Woodhouse could not have achieved these successes without everyone – teachers, pupils and parents – working together. Thank you so much for your continued support.
