'Be the Best' Programming Challenge Answers

To join the British Army, you have to be 16 years or older, but no older than 32 years old.



Using your knowledge of **selection, comparative operators** and **Boolean operators**, write a Python program that will do the following:

- 1. Ask the user to enter their age.
- 2. Output whether or not they are eligible to join the British Army.

When you have finished:

Test your program several times to make sure that it works.

Then test someone else's program.
